## Of the EE Meetings and the International Judge Meetings Poultry Section since 1990 General – Judgement Standard

<u>Shaking neck in poultry</u> : is a disqualification. Some times seen in Serama and Shamo.	Pohlheim 2025
<u>We do not want any over-tipification!</u> The judges have to make it clear by following this point by judging.	Pohlheim 2025
The colour <u>Splash</u> is related with the base colour and cannot be accepted in combination with another Colour. (No splash silver-duckwing etc.)	Pohlheim 2025
<u>Serama</u> in the extreme malaysian or modern type are cruel breedings hand have to be disqualified. There is an EE-Standard which follows the requirements for animal welfare in the correct way.	Keczketmet 2024
The <u>english curled goose</u> is added to the list as Sebastopol, because she is completely different in the type from the „european corled goose.	Pohlheim 2024
<u>Missing free view</u> on crested birds have to receive o.B. and have to be disqualified.	Pohlheim 2024
<u>Wild Pigeons</u> (Ornamental pigeons) belongs to the section poultry and will not be splitted.	Sofia 2023
<u>No new characteristics</u> on existing breeds (Featehr structures, comb types, feathered legs, crests, leg colours etc..)	Sofia 2023
The <u>German Turkeys</u> are divided in 2 Types, German Turkeys (heavy type) and German Rural Turkeys (the lighter type)	Wittgenthal 2023
The <u>Earlobes on Pavlov</u> is changed into: „covered by tghe beard, colour irrelevant.	Billund 2021
<u>Salmon Brahma</u> can only be accepted, if they have no black or blue marks in the neck colour.	Online 2020
On <u>double laced Barnevelds</u> please watch, that the lacing is wide and clear, we do not want to have a fourfold lacing.	Online 2020
<u>Nacked neck silkies</u> had already been showed on the European Show Belgrade 1987 and will be accepted as a breed. If there are some breeders interested, the countreis are advised to set them In the recognition procedure. This is valid for large breed and bantams. Only the heterozygot Varieties will be accepted, with beard and featers on the chest.	Trogir 2019
The <u>eyes of the spotted Silkies</u> are dark. Little clear depositions are accpected. Large faults: Mainly clear eyes.	Pohlheim 2019
<u>New breeds</u> which must be presented on a European Show, must be showed in 1.1 old animals and 2.2 jounng animals.	Billund 2018
<u>Renaming of the Wyandottes</u> . The Wyandotte type which is breded in Germany is named new as German Wyandotte (including the bantams). The original type will be named furthermore as Wyandotte. There are now 2 different breed types on Wandottes.	Pohlheim 2018
A new name is created fort he goose breed which is independernt and clearly different from Kolmogor Goose and Tula Fighting goose. The name is <u>crooked beak fighting goose</u> ..	Pohlheim 2018
<u>Not accepted</u> were: Silky in autosexing, Cochin bantams, in silky and Ternoise, identic with Coutraï.	Pohlheim 2017

<u>Missing toe nails on the 4<sup>th</sup> toe of all ducks</u> , will be punished from the beginning of the Show season 2016/17. They can reach maximum 95 points.	Pohlheim 2016
<u>Silkie in coucou</u> can have only 2 colours. No autosexable etc.	Pohlheim 2015
The <u>digital European Standard</u> was accepted unanimously. The action plan for the systematic review of all existing breeds was presented. After the acceptance by ESC-P, changes are only in cooperation with the ESK-G.	Sarajewo 2014
<u>Standard descriptions for new breeds</u> are developed in cooperation with the ESC-P and then applied as EE standard. Changes are only possible with the ESK-G.	Rust 2013
The <u>AOC class for poultry</u> is currently only approved in Germany.	Pohlheim 2013
<u>New colors varieties of Sebrights</u> can be only recognized if they are bicolor and the lacing has a different color, than the base color.	Pohlheim 2013
<u>Crested silky feathered breeds</u> will not be accepted.	Trebrechovice 2011
<u>New european breeds</u> have to be presented at an European Show and must be judged by the ESC-P. They decide over the acceptance.	Pohlheim 2011
<u>Strong feathered faces</u> of Orpington must be punished.	Pohlheim 2011
The <u>country of origin for Krüper, Courtes-Pattes etc.</u> will be changed in northwest European Country breed.	Toledo 2010
The german breed of the Czech goose will be called as <u>bohemian goose</u> .	Linz 2009
The <u>naked neck ducks</u> are not affiliated into the list of breeds and colour varieties because of animal welfare reasons.	Linz 2009
<u>Serama</u> are accepted only in one size.	Linz 2009
<u>Moset</u> shows to less differences to other accepted breeds an are declined.	Pohlheim 2009
<u>Zwerg-Paduaner und Zwerg-Holländer Haubenhühner</u> werden in allen Farbenschlägen in <u>gestruppt</u> zugelassen.	Trencin 2008
<u>Jugdes</u> must be accepted in the home countries and should have made the permission there.	Pula 2008
The OGBZ (D) is named as the <u>official judging base</u> for ornamental fowl on european shows.	Pula 2008
The beginning of a <u>third band</u> is tolerated on all varieties of the porcellain booted bantams.	Beek 2005
The <u>czech tuffed goose</u> is accepted as a independent breed.	Niederbronn 2004
The <u>English Leghorns</u> are accepted as a independent breed.	Héviz 2004
<u>European Breed Shows</u> can be placed only in the years between.	Sebnitz 2003
The leding standard will be get translated into <u>French</u> from Switzerland.	Leipzig 2003
The <u>over-large combed Japanese Bantams</u> will be not accepted for animal welfare reasons.	Leipzig 2003
<u>Australorp Bantams in salomon</u> were rejected too.	Leipzig 2003
Proposals of <u>acceptance of new breeds or colour varieties</u> are to send to the chairman of the standard commission until 1th of february.	Dudelange 2001
<u>Decisions</u> of the international juge meeting or the standard commission will get valid after acceptance of the minutes.	Dudelange 2001
<u>Duck foots</u> will be disqualified in all countries.	Sönderborg 1998
<u>Brest bones</u> in S-form will be even disqualified everywhere.	Sönderborg 1998
<u>One sided splitting wings</u> should be even everywhere a disqualification, but not all countries do it right now.	Sönderborg 1998

Old cocks, big and bantam must have <u>spurs</u> . By the 0.1 spurs in the length of a half of an pea are tolerated. Exceptions see standard.	Sönderborg 1998
<u>Cross folds</u> of the wattles is a disqualification fault	Beek 1997
<u>Long folds</u> of breeds with long wattles like (Japanese or Italians) are tolerated.	Beek 1997
If the <u>ring is under the spurs</u> of the male, and you can turn it lightly it is tolerated. But if it handicapped the animal in his way to walk, so is this a disqualification fault.	Beek 1997
The German Standard is accepted as the <u>leading standard</u> , all what you can find in it is automatically accepted for the EE-Standard.	Brdo 1997
<u>New breeds</u> can be accepted by the EE-Standard, if they are even accepted in the country of origin and a second country, or if they are showed on a EE Show as a new breed in a good quality.	Linz 1996
<u>New frizzle varieties</u> of poultry breeds are not to push, because of animal right reasons.	Linz 1996
On EE Shows there will be accepted turned or missing <u>toe-nails</u> by all breeds with a strong leg plumage.	Rez, 1993
On EE Shows a animal does <u>not be older than 6 years</u> , otherwise it will not be judged.	Rez, 1993
If a judge find on EE Show a animal with " <u>unnatural marks</u> " so he has to let sign the card of the chef judge and the show organisation has to inform the association of the native country.	Luxembourg 1990
